DIRECTIONS TO THE VIBRATION INSTITUTE, GEORGIA CHAPTER SEMINAR MARY CALDER CLUBHOUSE, 1201 WEST LATHROP AVE., SAVANNAH, GEORGIA

From Hotels on Bay Street: Take Bay Street west until you see the highway overpass for I-516. Go under the overpass, and at the traffic light - turn right - this is West Lathrop Ave. For the Clubhouse, stay on West Lathrop about ¼ mile until you see the sign for Intl. Paper at gate Blue 1. Turn left. Follow the road past two sets of railroad tracks and turn left at the next turn. Follow gravel road to Club House.

From I-16 Eastbound: Take I-16 East to I-516 West (aka 21 North) Exit #164B – Lynes Parkway toward Garden City. Take I-516 West to West Lathrop Ave. (about 1 mile).Exit 7B. Follow exit ramp to bottom, bear right. For Clubhouse, stay on West Lathrop about ¼ mile until you see Intl. Paper sign at gate Blue 1. Go left. Follow road past two sets of tracks, turn left at next road. Follow gravel road to Club House.

Hotels near Mary Calder Clubhouse are located within a few miles of the clubhouse and in downtown Savannah
